Entry requirements:

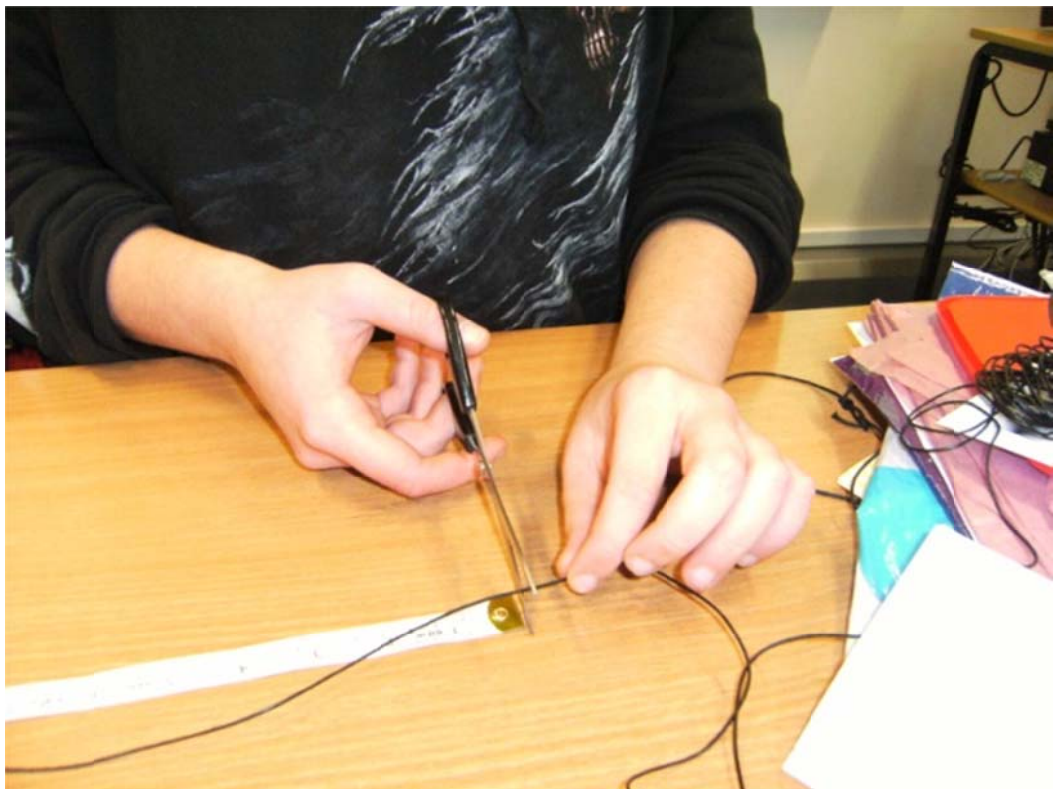
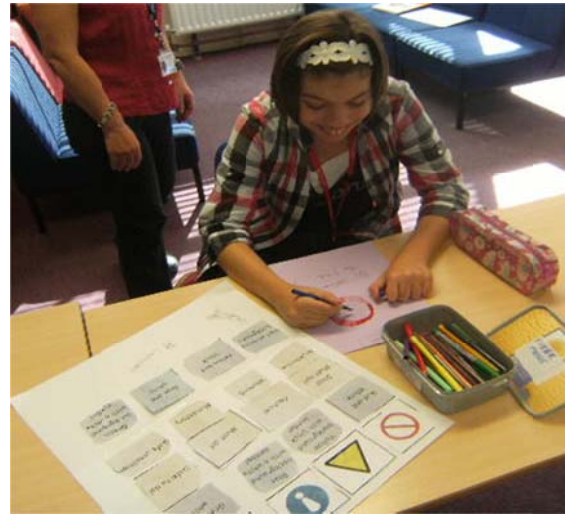
