Who is this course for?	The course is aimed to meet the individual needs of young people with moderate learning difficulties in order to prepare them for employment or supported employment.
What you will study:	Functional Skills in English, Maths and ICT Personal and social development Employability and enterprise skills Practical skills Vocational tasters (These may be based on another college site) Work placement Independent travel training if needed





Entry requirements:

16-24 years old with a moderate learning difficulty and would benefit from a course to prepare them for supported or open employment.
Independent travel skills or an ability to work towards.
Willingness to undertake work placements.

Progression:

You can progress to supported employment, employment, vocational Entry Level 3 or Level 1 programmes.

No formal qualifications are necessary.



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
