

Skills for Life:– Move On – Literacy/ Numeracy



Is this course for me?

If you would like to brush up on your English or Maths then this is the course for you. Join a Move On class and gain national English or Maths qualification.

We also offer a blended learning option with a focus on directed, independent study at home using online resources.

What will I learn?

Both English and Maths follow the Level 1 and Level 2 Adult National Core Curriculum.

In English some of the topics you will learn about are: identifying different types of text, analysing text to evaluate effectiveness, spelling strategies, writing for different purposes and proof reading to produce accurate pieces of writing.

In Maths some of the topics you will learn include: whole numbers, fractions, decimals, percentages, measurements of length, weight, capacity, temperature and money, comparing data using averages and range.

What does the course involve?

The Move On course is not a taught class, it is more of an autonomous course of 15 two hour sessions with an addition of 15 hours of independent study. On the blended learning option you will be expected to complete 9 hours directly in the college followed by 45 hours of study at home. Following your initial assessment and diagnostic assessment, an individual plan is produced for you to work on at your own pace on identified topics which needs improving, in a small friendly class and e-resources are also provided for you to access from home.

What qualifications or skills will I need to get on the course?

There are no entry qualifications for the course as you will be assessed for the course suitability at an initial assessment interview.

What options will be open to me if I successfully complete the course?

After successful completion of the Level 2 course you will have opportunities to progress onto GCSE, vocational college courses, gain a promotion or a better job.

How much will I have to pay?

You will not have to pay a penny. The course is free.
